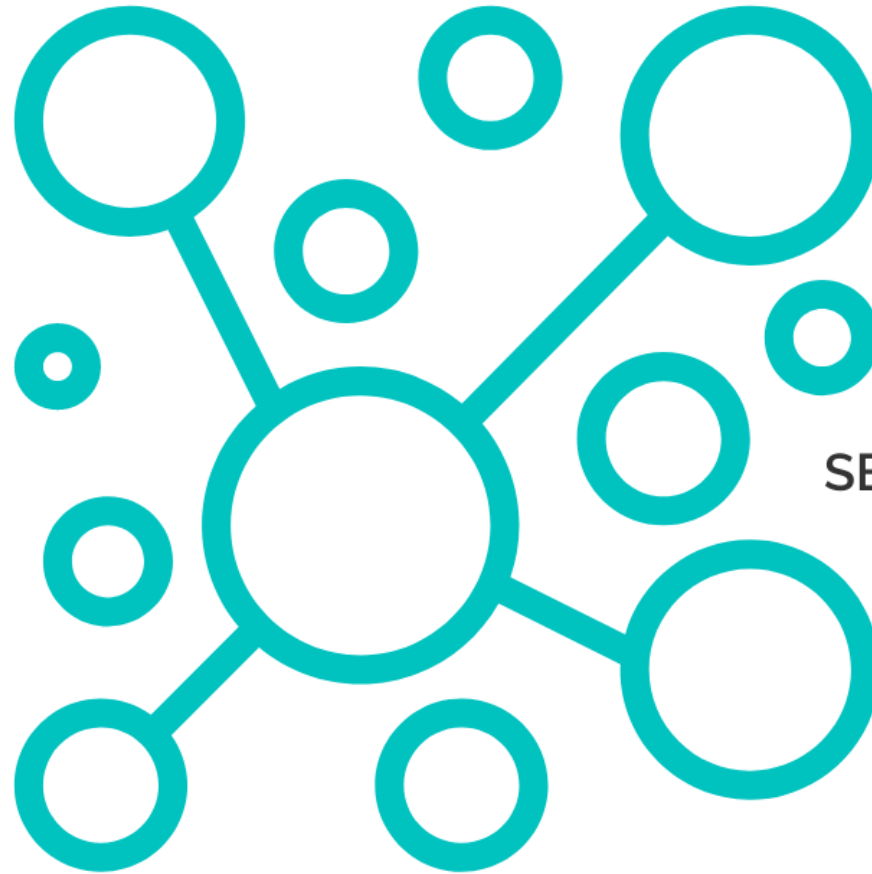

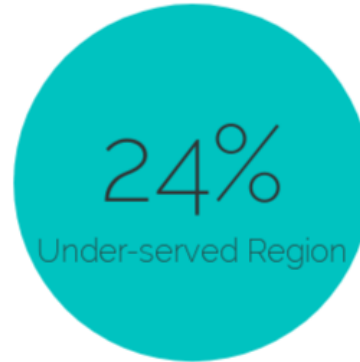

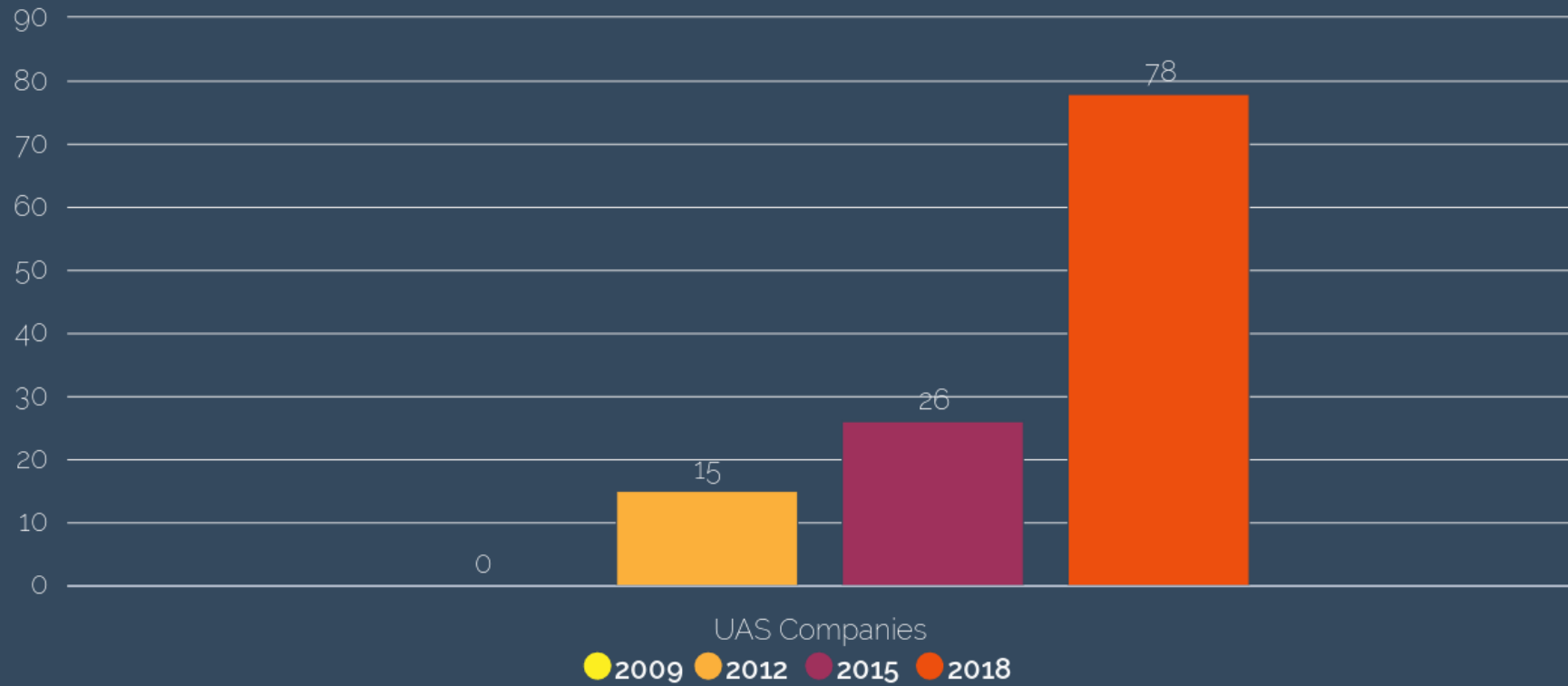
*Results on program - September 2014-2018
